Dear Valued PCA Staff & Recipients,

I am sending some info pertaining to a temporary rate increase for PCA Services. Beginning December 1st, 2020 through February 7th, 2021 the PCA reimbursement rate will be increased by 8.4% upon pending Federal Approval. This rate increase will be in response to Covid-19. MBK plans to give back 100% of that to you aside from 7.65% to simply match your Medicare and Social Security. This equals to \$1.37/hr increase which brings your total hourly wage to \$14.62.
