COVID-19 Hotline - Call 952-361-1559 if you are age 18 to 75 and experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (difficulty breathing, fever, cough). Available Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. -3 p.m. County Public Health staff will triage callers to see if they qualify for COVID-19 testing. If callers qualify, they'll be directed to the drive-through testing site. There's no cost associated with testing, administered by Ridgeview Medical Center staff.
